Ginger Johnson is a cause-driven entrepreneur, international speaker, mentor and trainer, woman of God, and 2-time #stage4nomore metastatic breast cancer survivor (NED) - first diagnosed on Halloween day when she was 31 years old and 5 months pregnant, then re-diagnosed with metastatic stage 4 disease on her 40th birthday in 2015. It hasn't slow her down.

Known for her optimism, enthusiasm, faith, resiliency, and make-it-happen determination, Ginger has been called the 'quintessential connector', 'a hope giver', and 'a force of nature'.

As a keynote speaker, she has delighted audiences internationally, sharing her story of survival, service and support, and guiding others to increase the hope, health and happiness in their lives. After receiving NED results in July 2017, Ginger is determined now, more than ever, to share her message of hope with the world.

Ginger has been featured on a variety of media outlets including NBCNews.com, USAToday, StandUp2Cancer, iHeart Media and magazines such as AmoenaLIFE, Breast Cancer Wellness, Coping with Cancer, Real Simple, Wildfire and more. Her image and story circled

Dr. Kierny completed a Fellowship in Surgical Breast Oncology at Stanford University. She earned 12 years in the U.S. Army serving numerous reconstructions and advancement medals.

That service led to the creation of several businesses including Henna Body Art and the USA Cancer Connection Magazine.

Ginger was re-diagnosed with stage 4 metastatic disease on her 4th birthday in 2016 and soon after began her 5th fight.
